Place of examination and registration

Come in through the Women's Hospital main entrance. Register with the self-registration kiosk and then follow the blue line on the floor. Follow the line to the X-ray unit on the 1st floor. Please stay in the waiting area with the text "Mammography and ultrasound examinations waiting room" on the door. A nurse will call you in for the scan.

Prepare for the examination according to the provided instructions.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination. Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.

Please bring with you

- Kela Card or identity card
- Mammography and breast ultrasound images from a private clinic as prints or on a CD, and their reports.

If you cannot come at the scheduled time, cancel the examination.

Cancel the examination as soon as possible or by noon on the weekday preceding the appointment at the latest by calling the number above.
