**Monday–Friday 8am–3:30pm**, please register in the X-ray Unit's office (1st floor) or using the self-registration kiosk.

**Monday–Friday before 8am, after 3:30pm, and on weekends** you can come directly to the X-ray Unit's lobby 2 from where you will be called in to your examination.

On weekends before 11am and on weekdays after 7pm, entrance via the emergency clinic. You do not need to register. Follow the purple-coloured line on the floor.

Please do not wear any strong fragrances when you come to the examination. Substances used in fragrances may cause serious symptoms in other people.
